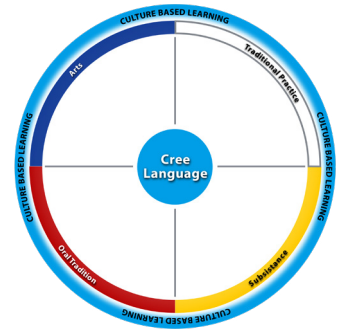
#### SYNOPSIS

ēkosi maka - that's all for now

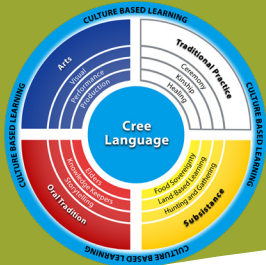
#### POSSIBLE USES
